The videographic works selected for the Festival will be screened at the Tel Aviv Cinematheque during the week of the Festival. We are looking for works that are distinctive, and that use an innovative approach – in either the explanatory or poetic modes or anywhere in between – to express their ideas.

Entry Requirements:

- Submission is open for students, teachers, scholars, critics and filmmakers.
- Each person can submit no more than two works.
- Submitted videos must be no longer than 20 min.
- Submitted videos must be created no earlier than January 2018.
- Submitted videos must be available for online viewing.
